# Spomini internirancev fašističnih taborišč

Razstava je poskus zgodovinske in družbene umestitve internacije civilnega prebivalstva v fašistična koncentracijska taborišča med letoma 1942 in 1943. Namenjena je ovrednotenju spomina na dogodke v času italijanske okupacije, ki so bili izpostavljeni pozabi in dolgo tabuizirani. V evropskem in mednarodnem merilu skuša zapolniti vrzel o poznavanju in priznanju italijanskih fašističnih taborišč in žrtev, med njimi zlasti civilnega prebivalstva tedanje Ljubljanske pokrajine in Primorske.

Na fotografijah so še redki živeči interniranci. Spomin na internirance in posredno izkušnjo internacije podajajo tudi njihovi sorodniki ali prijatelji. Razstavljen je izbor predmetov iz taborišč.

Materialni del razstave sta velikodušno podprla Muzej novejše zgodovine Slovenije in Znanstvenoraziskovalni center Slovenske akademije znanosti in umetnosti. Vsebinski del je povsem volunteerski. Sodelavke, Saša Petajan, Manca Juvan in Urška Strle, so projekt izpeljale iz humanističnih vzgibov. V intervjujih s pričevalci so ugtovile, da sedemdeseta obletnica kapitulacije Italije in razpustitev fašističnih taborišč še nista jamstvo, da so posledice internacije odpravljene.

O tem priča razstava **od 5. septembra do 28. oktobra 2013** v Muzeju novejše zgodovine Slovenije v Ljubljani.

*The aim of this exhibition is to place both historically and socially the internment of civilians in the fascist concentration camps during the period of 1942 and 1943. Its purpose is to evaluate the memories of the events that took place during the Italian occupation, which were taboo for a long time and were allowed to be forgotten. It is on a European and international level that this exhibition bridges the gap between understanding and recognizing the fascist concentration camps and the victims, among them primarily the civilian population, most of them either coming from the former Province of Ljubljana or the Primorska region.*

*The few prisoners who are still living are presented in these photos. The memories of the concentration camp prisoners provide an indirect experience of the internment for their relatives and friends. Selected items from the camps are exhibited here for this purpose.*

*This exhibition's material was financed both the Museum of Contemporary History of Slovenia and the Scientific Research Centre of the Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts, while its contents are the result of voluntary work. The project, carried out by the authors Saša Petajan, Manca Juvan and Urška Strle, has been driven by humanistic motives. During their many interviews with witnesses, they established that not even the 70th anniversary of the capitulation of Italy and the dissolution of the fascist camps guaranteed that the consequences of internment are resolved.*

*The exhibition taking place from September 5th to October 28th, 2013 at the Museum of Contemporary History of Slovenia in Ljubljana tells this story.*
